

Change in LDL Calculation Equation

Effective June 6, 2023 Change in LDL Calculation Equation

WHO: Ambulatory and inpatient providers, including Froedtert South, who order calculated LDL cholesterol as part of a lipid panel

WHAT: Currently, LDL cholesterol is calculated using the Friedewald equation, which generates an accurate estimate up to triglyceride concentrations of 400 mg/dL but underestimates LDL at triglyceride concentrations above this threshold. On 6/6/23, we will switch to the Sampson equation, which generates accurate estimates of LDL cholesterol up to triglyceride concentrations of 800 mg/dL.
