



Hematology Testing Update

Effective October 17, 2022 Body Fluid and CSF Cell Count and Differential Testing Updates

Effective Oct 17, 2022 Wisconsin Diagnostic Laboratories (WDL) and Froedtert Health Laboratories will transition to reporting Total Nucleated Cell Count (TNC) instead of White Blood Cell Count (WBC) in body fluid and CSF cell count analysis. This change reflects a more accurate reporting of the presence of nucleated cells.

The reference ranges for CSF TNC count will remain the same as CSF WBC. There is no Reference Range established for TNC for Body fluid analysis.

New differential result reporting will be as follows:

^{*}Fluid Lining Cells now encompasses the reporting of Fluid Mesothelial Cells in serous fluids, and Synovial Lining Cells in Synovial Fluid. Synovial and Bronchial Lining cells were previously reported as present in a result comment.
