


Epstein Barr Virus NAAT Change

Effective August 19, 2019 EPSTEIN BARR VIRUS NUCLEIC ACID AMPLIFIED TEST CHANGE



The Microbiology & Molecular Diagnostics
Department at Wisconsin Diagnostic Laboratories
will be transitioning Epstein Barr Virus Nucleic
Acid Amplified Test, Quantitative on plasma
(EBVPLNAATQT) from Copies/mL and Log
Copies/mL to International Units (IU)/mL and Log
IU/mL.

This transition will allow for more commutability of results across testing laboratories, and alignment with commercially available quality control materials.

Copies/mL, Log copies/mL, IU/mL and Log IU/mL will be co-reported for a period of time to allow traceability for those patients undergoing monitoring, after which we will report only IU/mL and Log IU/mL.
