

Sedimentation Rate Testing Updates

Effective July 10, 2019 SEDIMENTATION RATE TESTING UPDATES

Effective **July 10, 2019** Wisconsin Diagnostic Laboratories (WDL) will transition to a new automated method for Erythrocyte Sedimentation Rate (ESR) that will significantly reduce the time to result as compared to the manual method.

Specimen Transport and Stability are unchanged:

- Collect Lavender Top (EDTA) tube. Volume: 4 mL (minimum 2 mL)
- Store and transport specimen at room temperature or refrigerated (preferred)
- Specimen must be tested within 24 hours

Reference ranges will be different from the manual method.

Patients being monitored with the manual Westergren method may require re-baselining with the automated method. Clinicians with such patients are asked to call Client Services at 414.805.7600, within 24 hours of the collection, to request testing with both the automated and manual methods.
